Report for Bayview Park

200 responses to a Bayfield County website survey gave Bayview Beach the most votes.

After the Oct 27 storm there is a lot more sand and wood on the beach. The rings are still in their location, but tilted.

Report for HFNP

Split rail fence: In discussion about location near Bouchard property line, the consensus was agreement with Charly's suggestion

to put this fence, from the inward extension of the lake at an angle toward the property line further inland.

This fence location is intended to stop traffic to the narrow space between the existing fence and the cliff, out to the point.

Permits are in process for the work to be done, thanks to the Coastal Management grant and the matching funds loan to be paid by the room tax.

Carpenter friends of Jay Cablk want to honor him by volunteering their labor in making improvements at HFNP.

Suggestion was made to have a bench built in his memory, to recognize his building the boardwalk.

Historic buildings and Cultural Heritage Center

The quarry building was the paymaster's building, confirmed by Cindy Warren. The building is now completed on the inside.

The Center application to Wisconsin Historical Society is being worked on, as reported by Charly.
